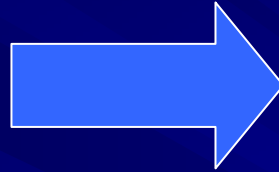
Hearing God's audible voice:

Place of the Transfiguration

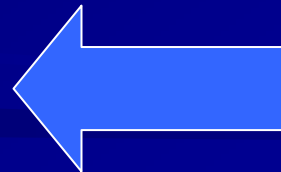
Peter identifies
