# CONSIDERING OUR SPIRITUAL LEGACY

## Isaiah 53: 10 – 11

- <sup>10</sup> But the LORD was pleased to crush Him, putting {Him} to grief; If He would render Himself {as} a guilt offering, He will see {His} offspring, He will prolong {His} days, And the good pleasure of the LORD will prosper in His hand.
- <sup>11</sup> As a result of the anguish of His soul, He will see {it and} be satisfied; By His knowledge the Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many, As He will bear their iniquities.

# CONSIDERING OUR SPIRITUAL LEGACY

## Genesis 15: 1 – 21

- <sup>1</sup> After these things the word of the LORD came to Abram in a vision, saying, "Do not fear, Abram, I am a shield to you; Your reward shall be very great."
- <sup>2</sup> Abram said, "O Lord GOD, what will You give me, since I am childless, and the heir of my house is Eliezer of Damascus?"

# CONSIDERING OUR SPIRITUAL LEGACY

- 3 And Abram said, "Since You have given no offspring to me, one born in my house is my heir."
- 4 Then behold, the word of the LORD came to him, saying, "This man will not be your heir; but one who will come forth from your own body, he shall be your heir."

# CONSIDERING OUR SPIRITUAL LEGACY

- <sup>5</sup> And He took him outside and said, "Now look toward the heavens, and count the stars, if you are able to count them." And He said to him, "So shall your descendants be."
- <sup>6</sup> Then he believed in the LORD; and He reckoned it to him as righteousness.

# CONSIDERING OUR SPIRITUAL LEGACY

<sup>7</sup> And He said to him, "I am the LORD who brought you out of Ur of the Chaldeans, to give you this land to possess it."

<sup>8</sup> He said, "O Lord GOD, how may I know that I will possess it?"

# CONSIDERING OUR SPIRITUAL LEGACY

- 9 So He said to him, "Bring Me a three year old heifer, and a three year old female goat, and a three year old ram, and a turtledove, and a young pigeon."
- 10 Then he brought all these to Him and cut them in two, and laid each half opposite the other; but he did not cut the birds.
- 11 The birds of prey came down upon the carcasses, and Abram drove them away.

# CONSIDERING OUR SPIRITUAL LEGACY

- 12 Now when the sun was going down, a deep sleep fell upon Abram; and behold, terror {and} great darkness fell upon him.
- 13 {God} said to Abram, "Know for certain that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not theirs, where they will be enslaved and oppressed four hundred years.

# CONSIDERING OUR SPIRITUAL LEGACY

- 14 But I will also judge the nation whom they will serve, and afterward they will come out with many possessions.
- 15 "As for you, you shall go to your fathers in peace; you will be buried at a good old age.
- 16 "Then in the fourth generation they will return here, for the iniquity of the Amorite is not yet complete."

# CONSIDERING OUR SPIRITUAL LEGACY

- 17 It came about when the sun had set, that it was very dark, and behold, {there appeared} a smoking oven and a flaming torch which passed between these pieces.
- 18 On that day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, "To your descendants I have given this land, From the river of Egypt as far as the great river, the river Euphrates:

- 19 the Kenite and the Kenizzite and the  
Kadmonite
- 20 and the Hittite and the Perizzite and the  
Rephaim
- 21 and the Amorite and the Canaanite and the  
Girgashite and the Jebusite."

# CONSIDERING OUR SPIRITUAL LEGACY

- Genesis 15:1 KJV & Hebrews Names Version:

“After these things the word of the LORD came unto Abram in a vision, saying, “Fear not, Abram: I (am) thy shield, (and) thy exceedingly great reward.”

# CONSIDERING OUR SPIRITUAL LEGACY

## EXODUS 19: 16 -18

<sup>16</sup> So it came about on the third day, when it was morning, that there were thunder and lightning flashes and a thick cloud upon the mountain and a very loud trumpet sound, so that all the people who {were} in the camp trembled.

# CONSIDERING OUR SPIRITUAL LEGACY

- 17 And Moses brought the people out of the camp to meet God, and they stood at the foot of the mountain.
- 18 Now Mount Sinai {was} all in smoke because the LORD descended upon it in fire; and its smoke ascended like the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mountain quaked violently.

## ISAIAH 9:6

For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.

# CONSIDERING OUR SPIRITUAL LEGACY

PSALMS 40: 6 -8 (NIV)

- 6 Sacrifice and offering you did not desire, but a body thou hast prepared for me; burnt offerings and sin offerings you did not require.
- 7 Then I said, "Here I am, I have come-- it is written about me in the scroll.
- 8 I desire to do your will, O my God; your law is within my heart."

# CONSIDERING OUR SPIRITUAL LEGACY

## ROMANS 4: 18 -21

- 18 In hope he believed against hope, that he should become the father of many nations; as he had been told, "So shall your descendants be."
- 19 He did not weaken in faith when he considered his own body, which was as good as dead because he was about a hundred years old, or when he considered the barrenness of Sarah's womb.

# CONSIDERING OUR SPIRITUAL LEGACY

- 20 No distrust made him waver concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong in his faith as he gave glory to God,
- 21 fully convinced that God was able to do what he had promised.
