Elizabeth de Smidt, like her brothers before her, competes with her FIRST LEGO LEAGUE (FLL) Robotics team, Lords of the Brick. FLL is a worldwide program that encourages today's youth to get excited about science and technology. This hands-on program for children 9-14 years old uses challenges based on current world problems to engage team members to research, collaborate, and use engineering skills to look for realistic solutions. FLL emphasizes friendly sportsmanship, learning, and community involvement.

Working in teams and guided by adult coaches and mentors, the team members build an autonomous robot to carry out "missions." The robots are built and programmed with the Lego Mindstorms system.

they then come up with a viable solution. This year, the subject was the "human water cycle."

The Lords of the Brick is one of three FLL teams sponsored by the Pittsford Community Church chapter of LEAH (Loving Education At Home). The team won the Champion's Award at the Webster Qualifying Competition on November 18, 2017. On December 10, 2017, they competed among the best teams at the Finger Lakes Regional Championship at the University of Rochester and won the coveted Champion's Award for the entire Finger Lakes Region, earning a spot at the World Championships in Detroit, Michigan! This is an opportunity for the Lords of the Brick to interact and compete with over 100 teams representing all 50 states and 35 other countries.

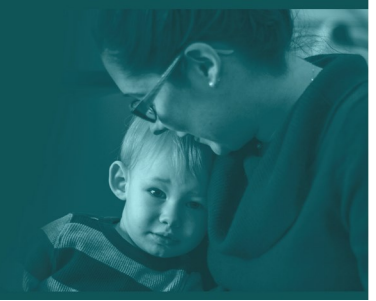


Rev. Ron Burgio at WOL, March 4
