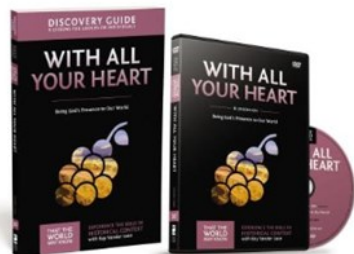

The D'Alessandro Life Group

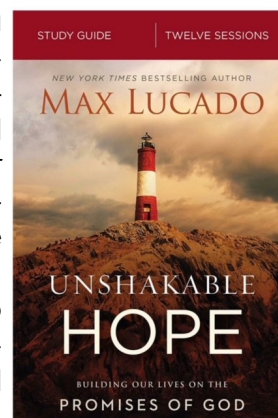

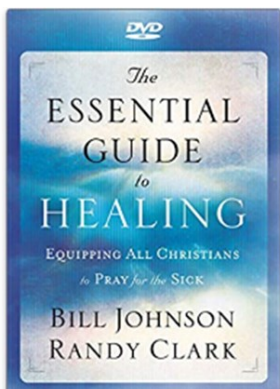
The Fantauzzo Life Group

The McDonald Life Group



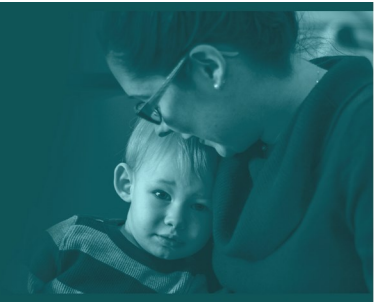

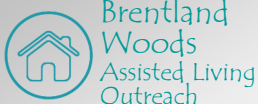
