We need to be aware of how he tries to destroy us with his schemes to divide us.

Unity must be guarded!! We must at times make decisions to guard unity. Years ago, a friend of mine did something that could have easily offended a friend of hers. She went to the friend and asked forgiveness, but the deed was already done. The friend said, "This is not anything our friendship can't handle." Her friend made a choice to guard the unity. She forgave. Don't be unaware of the devil's schemes and his slyness to break unity!

## Brentland Woods Outreach

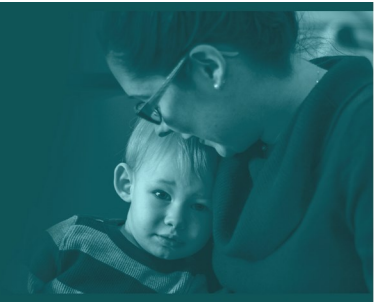
