

## A Note from Pastor Phil

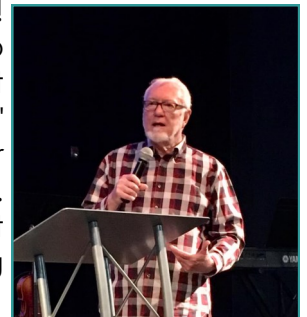

## Year-End Giving Opportunities 2018

It is hard to believe we will be in the New Year in just a few weeks. This is just a note to remind you that to be credited to this year, giving must be postmarked by December 31, 2018, or given in a regular offering at the church on Sunday, December 30, 2018. You can also give online up to December 31. A more detailed list of year-end giving opportunities (which includes Missions and Compass Care) is available at Info Central or through the church office.

Another opportunity is our "Building For Increase" pledge. I want to thank everyone for their faithful giving to the building fund last year. We were able to finish the walls and all the flooring in the Auditorium. Doesn't it look great! We believe God to help us raise \$50,100 for the following projects. Please understand these are the best estimates for each step and will not necessarily be done in the following order. Also, if you give a partial donation to any step we have to wait for it all to come in. So far, we have about \$2,000, and believe to start nursery renovation in January.

Step 1 Nursery Remodel \$2,500 (We are presently hoping for contractors to start in January.)

Step 2 Auditorium Lighting \$14,000 (We already have \$5,000) = \$9,000 is now needed.

Step 3 Sound Equipment \$3,000 (In-ear monitors and Drum enclosure.)

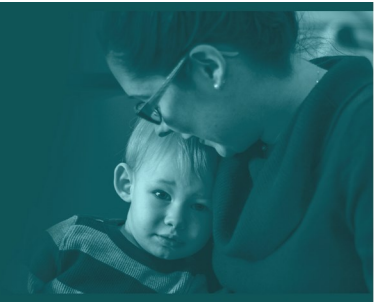
Step 4 Parking Lot Increase and Repair \$25,000

Step 5 Live Streaming \$10,600

Step 6 New chairs \$8,000 (This is the cost for 100 new chairs. We only need to raise \$7,000.)
