

A Note from Pastor Phil on Healings

Over the last several months, we have seen an increase in healings here at Word of Life. The increase is not only in the number of healings, but in the frequency in which the testimonies are being given. Although we have seen healings in the past, this is a fresh emphasis in our church body. I want to share with you some of the testimonies that we have received. Some of these are from the fall when we had Nick Watson minister prophetically and in healing during special services at Word of Life. Other testimonies have come in since Mike McDonald preached on healing at the end of January. One testimony was from a woman healed of arthritis in her wrists.

From Leah Altier, 11/5/8: For several years I had been struggling with inflammation and arthritis. Truthfully, I have absolutely no recollection of what Nick spoke over me as he laid hands on me...the anointing was so heavy I immediately fell in the Spirit, but I can tell you distinctly what happened to me physically. I felt something like a hand (not the catcher...my Pastor thankfully caught me at my shoulders and according to him...it was as though I rocketed straight back) curve and cup my spine. From the tailbone up, I felt this gentle removal of each vertebrae and it being softly popped back into place...there was heat in my back, but it was soothing and comforting not painful and burning. The pain in my back stopped, I felt my hips level out and the ball and socket joints in my pelvis straighten out and cushion added to it. My shoulders relaxed, all the pressure and tension I had in my upper back left. I felt completely straight and even, my legs loosened and felt lengthened. My wrists, finger joints, ankles and each toe joint softly popped like my back had and suddenly all the inflammation, heavy feeling, swelling and fuzzy sensation left my body. Completely healed!!! I immediately felt lighter, mobile, agile, I have range of motion and flexibility again. My body is moving in comfort and strength and energy. As I briefly described in my testimony before the Sunday evening service...what has happened is that every weight that I felt was attached to



each joint has been traded and replaced with little pillows at each muscular-skeletal connection. I do not have pain. I can hold and carry my son easily and without difficulty. I can hold him and sway or walk to soothe him without pain! My spine does not "catch on fire," my hips are not grinding and rolling bone on bone! I can kneel and easily pick him up and my knees are strong and cushioned, not crashing on gravel and stone!

From Sue Hunter, 11/9/18: Ten months ago I visited a specialist for a concern my doctor had about my bladder. I came to Bro. Nick's meetings believing for my healing. Sunday evening I did what he said. I stood for healing not prayer, I stood in faith not hope, and I believed that Jesus was in the room just for me. I was healed.

From Fran Kreider, 2/1/19: My feet were healed Sunday from pain I had been experiencing sometimes when I walked after sitting a while. I'd hobble along. Libby and Linda prayed for me, and as they did I had a tingling or zinging in my foot and it felt warm and wet. I had the wet sensation again the next day, and have had no pain at all in my feet.

From Janet Smith, 2/4/19: I did receive a healing during our latest alter call. This healing was on multiple levels, and was initially felt physically in my shoulder (which was suffering some pain caused by "wear and tear" from my occupation as a massage therapist.) Through my sharing the physical and spiritual challenges I face daily with the healing ministers, they prayed over me and I immediately felt "heat" in my shoulder as their physical touch and words of the Holy Spirit was bestowed upon me.

From Ralph and Pat Gossage, 2/10/19: Bob Noone, our son-in-law, was diagnosed with stage 4 nasopharyngeal cancer involving the base of the skull. That was back in September. Bob had to go through 17 weeks of radiation every day and chemo once a week. After the 17 weeks of treatment they went to the doctor for a report. They were told that there was no change in the tumor and that he couldn't get any more radiation and they didn't even know if they would give him more chemo. Sometime in this period, the prophet, from Australia, called Ralph up to be prayed for. Ralph asked that he first pray for Bob. The prophet repeated three times that Bob would live a long life. After the next doctors appointment, my daughter, Rachel, called me so distraught. She actually said that she barely heard anything the doctor said just because his tone and body language said that Bob is dying and there was nothing that can be done. I kept thinking about what the prophet said. A lot of people were praying for Bob. One day Ralph went for a walk and was praying, and he heard, so clearly from God, that Bob would be healed. Rachel said that she couldn't sleep that night. That day, three weeks after the terrible doctor's appointment and all looked so hopeless, Bob went to have a procedure where a camera is put down his nose and to check the tumor. My daughter is a nurse and she remembers the first time this was done. She clearly saw the tumor on the screen. This time, when the procedure was done, she saw no tumor. The doctor kept saying "where the tumor WAS. As Bob and Rachel were leaving the office, a nurse came up to them and introduced herself as the Survivor nurse and that she would be talking to them at the next appointment.
