The power of the cross has made you powerful and effective in prayer. Right now as you read this lift your prayer before the Lord and believe for victory.

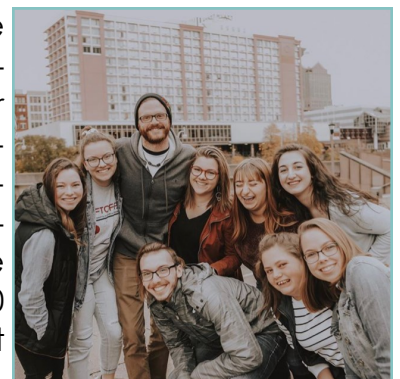

One way this ministry reaches the college students is to host a conference with solid Biblical teaching, passionate worship, and life-changing ministry. This is what BASICCON is all about! The next BASICCON will be held in Downtown Rochester on April 3-5, 2020, where over 600 students will be eternally impacted for Christ, and you can play a part in this!

So why the fundraiser? The purpose of the fundraiser is to raise scholarship funds to send students to the conference. This is an opportunity to help students get to a life line that will minister to their spiritual person when they need it the most. The cost for one student to attend is \$129 for registration and hotel, or \$90 for commuter registration. We want to offset the cost for Roberts BASIC students. 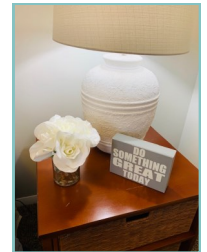

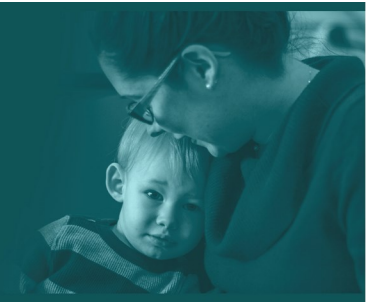
